Woman hit by car crossing busy Delray Beach street dies

A woman who was hit by a vehicle in Delray Beach Thursday evening has died, police say.

Marie Yvonne Dorelien, 65, was crossing Congress Avenue, north of Linton Boulevard, about 6:43 p.m. when she was hit by an oncoming vehicle, said Delray police spokeswoman Sgt. Nicole Guerriero.

Guerriero said Dorelien was not at a crosswalk as she headed east toward Linton Square Plaza when she was struck by a 1993 gray Chevrolet Camaro. Dorelien was taken to Delray Medical Center where she later died.

The driver of the Camaro, a young male whose age was not provided, was travelling south on Congress Avenue when his vehicle struck Dorelien. At this point, no charges have been filed against the driver, Guerriero said.

The investigation is ongoing. Anyone with information regarding the incident is asked to contact investigator Justin Reed at (561) 243-7800.
