5 suffer minor injuries after pick-up truck crashes in suburban Palm Beach Gardens

PALM BEACH GARDENS — Five people suffered minor injuries when a pick-up truck crashed near the intersection of Hood Road and Alternate A1A in suburban Palm Beach Gardens this afternoon.

Palm Beach Gardens and Palm Beach County fire rescue crews were called to the scene today at 1:49 p.m. Initial reports indicate some of those injured may have been riding in the truck's bed, County Fire Rescue spokesman Capt. Albert Borroto said.

The patients, whose ages and gender were not available, were taken to Jupiter and Palm Beach Gardens medical centers, Borroto said.
